Re: 5A Classification Equity Focused Proposal

We, the Superintendents of the Hillsboro and Forest Grove School Districts, respectfully submit the following equity based classification proposal for consideration. This proposal's primary aim is to spread the statewide goal of educational equity onto the athletic fields and courts of Oregon.

At the heart of this proposal is the goal of competitive league balance. It is NOT about playoff berths or league championships, but the opportunity to give student-athletes and their coaches the hope of being competitive in their respective league. It's clearer now more than ever that the demographics of a school - not just its' total enrollment - is the main predictor of their ability to compete.

We agree with the OSAA's assertion that Athletics and Activities are incredibly important and have a significant positive impact on the academic achievement of those students who participate. Furthermore, when competition is truly competitive and balanced, it provides student-athletes with an optimal zone for character development. Competitively balanced environments also promote participation and optimizes safety. Unfortunately, our experience has been that the current alignment does not maximize the OSAA's assertion, and doesn't align with the value of equity in education in our state. In recent years, we have witnessed a decrease in participation across athletics with a precipitous drop in football. Our current alignment does not maximize equity, and therefore will continue to undermine the very values that most of us would like to see our athletic environments provide. It is for that reason we believe our proposal will be beneficial to not only our schools, but other schools around the state. Our proposal makes slight changes to a few leagues using an equity perspective. It also creates a new league that keeps all four Hillsboro schools together, and adds the schools of Forest Grove, McMinnville, Newberg and Canby, which are more aligned in size and demographics.

Our proposal includes optimal league sizes of eight schools. We believe that making leagues with 10 or more schools is a disservice to equity for student-athletes, and undermines the cohesion of adult leaders in the league. We feel there is value in non-league games, and experiencing inter-league play with teams from different regions around the state.

We acknowledge that the limitations of our collective experiences do not allow us to have as sharp of an equity lens over the smaller classification levels, and thus their league alignments. It is for this reason that we left these current classifications unchanged.

It is our hope that the Classification Committee not only accepts this proposal, but also considers the concept of creating new football divisions based on game results and program numbers, rather than proximity or historical leagues. The football numbers at our respective schools have plummeted over the past three years, and safety should be our number one consideration in the creation of more equitable football levels.

- Provides Canby with more competitive balance than Three Rivers.

#### Statewide Football Plan

In order to achieve optimal football equity within this 5 class proposal, there would be multi-leveled football leagues formed. This would allow football programs within the same classification to play at different levels depending on the recent success and health of their programs. We encourage the development of an annual review to place football teams into these leagues. This could happen at the league level with predetermined criteria that allows leagues to decide which schools play in which football levels. We are hoping for further conversation and input on the development of a football plan that further levels teams based on equity first and then proximity and overall enrollment.
