SUBJECT: Summary of Executive Board Action at the December 12, 2022, Meeting

At the meeting on December 12, 2022, the OSAA Executive Board took the following actions:

- Approved the minutes of the following Board Meetings:

- Adopted the 2022-23 Winter Plan Books.
- Received a review of the October 2022 Delegate Assembly Caucus Item Discussions
- Adopted a three-year Membership Dues and Fees schedule. **(Attached)**
- Received an update on a potential revision to Article 9.10 - Equity and Diversity Advisory Committee which would change its composition to include the OSAA Inclusion Committee. Proposal forwarded to the February Executive Board Meeting Agenda.
- Appointed Brent Barry, Superintendent, Phoenix-Talent School District, as the temporary 4A Classification Executive Board representative.
- Adopted 2023 Fall Special Districts. **(Attached)**

### 3.3. Dues.

3.3.1. The Executive Board shall establish procedures relative to payment of membership dues and special fees for championships.

(a) Full Membership Dues. Full Member school dues are \$1,250, plus \$85 for each OSAA sponsored activity in which the school participates, payable on or before October 15 of each school year.

(b) Associate Membership Dues. Associate Member school dues are based on the number of students attending the Associate Member school (\$100 for 1-100 students; \$250 for 101-500 students; \$500 for 501+ students). Associate Member school students are not eligible to practice or participate in a contest until the Associate Member school is listed on the OSAA website.

3.3.2. If a member brings an administrative or judicial challenge to any Regulations or Rules of the Association and/or a final determination of the Executive Board or the Eligibility Appeals Board, and the Association is the prevailing party, the member shall be assessed a membership surcharge equal to the Association's attorney fees and costs actually incurred in defending such action, whether at the administrative or trial court level or on appeal or discretionary review.
