The Activity Advisory Committee meeting was called to order by Lauren Brownrigg at 3:32pm. There was a review of the agenda and minutes. A motion to approve the Fall 2026 minutes was unanimously approved.

The OSAA and Executive Board report was provided by Peter Weber and David Nieslanik. Peter provided updates on OSAA Executive Board changes, the Executive Board adopted the budget for next year and a review of several committees that completed their work including the Classification and Districting Committee ([Final](#)), and the State Championships Committee ([Final](#)). Activity Reports:

Cheerleading: Shelby: Noted they are working on the changes adopted by the State Championship committee for next year and will discuss logistics at an upcoming OCCA Meeting.

Dance: Elle & Amanda: Brought forward two proposals, the first regarding the placement of breaks for judges in the State Championship schedule. After discussion it was concluded that Lauren would work directly with the DDCA and JA Commissioner to review the needs of schools and judges and find a solution that may not require policy change. The other proposal was regarding the blocking process for the state championship schedule. After several questions, it was recommended that Lauren meet with the DDCA Board and JA leadership to fine tune the proposal and return with it at the Fall Activity Advisory Committee meeting.

Band and Orchestra: No update at this time.

Choir: Karen brought forward a proposal for redistricting small schools in music (choir, band & orchestra) to increase participation. Both ACDA and OBDA representatives are generally supportive of this proposal but suggest their associations review the proposal and provide time for feedback from their membership. This could be accomplished over the summer, brought back to the Committee and implemented by next academic year. Karen also mentioned Choir is working on updating rubrics for sight reading and judging to improve clarity and alignment with the new rating system.

Speech: Jennifer & Patrick: Reviewed the success of recent redistricting changes, which made the system more equitable and resulted in about 60 programs participating in state competitions with improved placement outcomes.

Solo: No update at this time.
