ACTIVITIES ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Summary / September 23, 2025 / 3:30pm Zoom

The Activity Advisory Committee meeting was called to order by Lauren Brownrigg at 3:30pm. There was a review of the agenda and minutes. A motion to approve the Spring 2025 minutes was unanimously approved.

The OSAA and Executive Board report was provided by Peter Weber and David Nieslanik. Peter provided updates on several committees that are at work this year, including the Classification and Districting Committee (update), the State Championships Committee (to begin work in January), and the Transfer Eligibility Task-Force (update). Peter also mentioned an update to cooperative sponsorship policy allowing for large classifications to participate as a Coop without receiving scores or qualifications for the state championship, in an effort to support programs that are trying to build. He also reiterated that all proposals from activities will continue to come through Activity Advisory Committee. Lastly, an update on the most recent Executive Board meeting can be found here.

Activity Reports:

<u>Cheerleading:</u> Shannon: A pilot adjustment for divisions at the Game Day State Championships was approved by the Executive Board in September to address the scheduling and adjudication issue of this growing championship. This season there will be 1-3A, 4A, 5A and a 6A division. A longer-term proposal will be given to the Championship Committee in the spring for consideration.

Dance: Elle & Amanda: Reported a projected positive growth in Dance/Drill programs this year.

Band and Orchestra: No update at this time.

Choir: No update at this time.

<u>Speech:</u> Jennifer & Patrick: Continuing to work to develop programs and seeing a positive trend, however concerned with some colleges in the area starting to end their speech programs and tournaments, which could affect certain areas of the state.
