a. KSI/Team Up for Sports Safety Takeaways

1. Emergency Action Plans – Board Policy and School Safety Officer Requirement (attachment)

Marc Norcross put together language looking at the OSAA asking schools to identify School Safety Officer to direct OSAA communication to. The Committee doesn't see a reason for schools or districts to hire a new staff member, just identify the point person. Would likely be an AD or Risk Management person.

2. AED/CPR Training – Legislation Update – LC 125 (attachment)

Legislation to be implemented in the 2027-28 school year. The Committee is concerned that there is no funding for the bill as originally proposed.

3. Pre-Participation Exams – Best Practices for Storage and Management of Physical Forms and OSAA SMAC Pre-Participation Physical Examination Review Guidance (attachment)

The Committee would like to establish a process to review the current PPE form. They would also like to put out a statement with guidance to schools on best practices for storing forms.

b. Medical Release – Return to Participation Following a Concussion and ITAP (attachment)

Working with ODE to support new legislation and ITAP. OSAA removed Return to Learn recommendations and replaced with ITAP language. Subcommittee to review OSAA Return to Participation and correct any conflicting information.

Concerns and confusion with how schools implement this and how it could conflict with Max's Law. Do not want people to feel like they have to remove ALL accommodations to return to participation.

Focusing on Return to PE language. Concerned with language specifically in the form.
