SUBJECT: Summary of Delegate Assembly Action at the December 15, 2025, Meeting

At the meeting on December 15, 2025, the OSAA Delegate Assembly took the following actions:

- Voted to Amend Article 6.2.4. – Classification Thresholds which amends current classification cutoff points as adopted by the Executive Board. (attached)
- Voted to Amend Article 7 – Representative Districts which amends the regular districts at each classification level as adopted by the Executive Board. (attached)
- Voted to Amend Article 4.1. – Delegate Assembly which amends Delegate Assembly composition due to changes in the number of Representative Districts. (attached)

Proposal to Amend Article 6.2.4. – Classification Thresholds

(Adopted 12/15/2025)

QUESTION: *Should the Delegate Assembly amend Article 6.2.4. – Classification Thresholds to make the classification cutoff points consistent with the classification and districting alignment adopted by the Executive Board?*

RATIONALE: The Classification and Districting Committee recommended these cutoff points to the Executive Board for consideration. The Delegate Assembly must vote to amend the cutoff points as they are contained in the Articles of the OSAA Handbook.

Article 6.2.4. – Classification of Schools – Classification Thresholds

Classification of Schools – Classification Thresholds. During the four-year time block, the following Average Daily Membership (ADM) thresholds will be used by the Executive Board when considering school placement or classification changes:

6A: 1005 1026 or more	4A: 311 to 607 281 to 580	2A: 75 to 145 66 to 140
5A: 608 to 1004 581 to 1025	3A: 146 to 310 141 to 280	1A: 10 to 74 65

EXCEPTION: OSAA member schools shall participate based upon ADM in the classifications defined in this Article unless an exception has been granted by the Executive Board in response to the submission of a Petition to Play Down, a Petition to Play Up, or Placement in a Different Classification – Football Only.

Proposal to Amend Article 7 – Representative Districts

(Adopted 12/15/2025)

QUESTION: *Should the Delegate Assembly amend Article 7 – Representative Districts to reflect the athletic districts at each classification level that were adopted by the Executive Board?*

RATIONALE: The Classification and Districting Committee recommended changes to the total number of districts to the Executive Board for consideration. The Delegate Assembly must vote to amend the number of representative districts as they are contained in the Articles of the OSAA Handbook.

Article 7 – Representative Districts

7.1 Regular and Special Athletic Districts. The high schools of the state shall be divided into ~~seven~~ **six** regular athletic districts for 6A, four regular athletic districts for 5A, six regular athletic districts for 4A, seven regular athletic districts for 3A, ~~six~~ **eight** regular athletic districts for 2A, eight regular athletic districts for 1A **and two hybrid athletic districts** as follows:

7.1.1 6A: Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, ~~7~~

5A: Districts 1, 2, 3, 4

4A: Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6

3A: Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7

2A: Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, **7, 8**

1A: Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8

Two Hybrid Districts

Proposal to Amend Article 4.1. – Delegate Assembly – Composition

(Adopted 12/15/2025)

QUESTION: *Should the Delegate Assembly amend Article 4.1 – Delegate Assembly – Composition to reflect changes in the composition of the Delegate Assembly as a result of changes in the number of Representative Districts?*

RATIONALE: The Classification and Districting Committee recommended changes to the total number of districts to the Executive Board for consideration. The Delegate Assembly must vote to amend the composition of the Delegate Assembly to reflect these changes as they are contained in the Articles of the OSAA Handbook.

Article 4 – Delegate Assembly

4.1. Composition. The Delegate Assembly shall be composed of ~~44~~ **47** representatives:

4.1.1. ~~Thirty-eight~~ **Forty-one** representatives elected by the members of regular districts.

4.1.2. A representative of the Oregon Athletic Directors Association.

4.1.3. A representative of the OSAA Activities Advisory Committee.

4.1.4. A representative of the Oregon School Boards Association.

4.1.5. A representative of the OSAA Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Advisory Committee.

4.1.6. A representative of the Oregon Athletic Coaches Association.

4.1.7. A representative of the Oregon Athletic Officials Association.

4.1.8. The Executive Director shall be ex-officio, non-voting member of the Delegate Assembly.
