## Track & Field / XC Officials Registration & Certification Timeline – 2026

### OFFICIAL REGISTERS

- Consents to background check
- Completes all registration steps
- Pays the registration fee

Email with registration confirmation and receipt of payment is sent from ArbiterSports ([messaging@arbitersports.com](mailto:messaging@arbitersports.com))



Added to OSAA group of officials and T&F specific sub-group



Online tests and clinics are available (*rules exam/concussion*)

1 to 3 Business Days



Background checks are submitted every work day by noon to initiate the screening (*may take up to 3 days to process*)



**Registered** badge appears once background check clears (*previous officials may clear faster than new officials*)



3 to 5 Business Days



Officials packet is shipped with a tracking number (*mail batches are processed every 2-3 business days*)



Email confirmation with tracking number is sent once registration has been processed in a mail batch ([shipping@osaa.org](mailto:shipping@osaa.org))



Packet may take 2 to 3 days to be delivered via USPS (*undeliverable packets may be returned to the OSAA office due to incomplete or invalid addresses which will delay packets*)



Email confirmation is sent once free digital rule book and case book are available from the NFHS ([allaccess@nfhs.org](mailto:allaccess@nfhs.org))



<p><b>OFFICIAL TAKES THE ONLINE OSAA CONCUSSION COURSE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Successfully completes the OSAA's "Understanding Concussions – What Officials Need to Know" training course via ArbitrSports</li><li>• Annual requirement in compliance with state law</li><li>• 8-minute training course designed for officials</li><li>• Also available in Spanish</li></ul> <p>+</p>
<p><b>OFFICIAL TAKES THE ONLINE OSAA IPDA TRAINING COURSE</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Successfully completes the OSAA's "Interrupting and Preventing Discriminatory Acts" training course via ArbitrSports</li><li>• One-time requirement in compliance with state law</li><li>• If completed in a prior year, you're good to go, no need to re-take</li><li>• 20-minute training course</li></ul>
